CONTRACT

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a Mental Health Deputies Program in Collin County. This agreement is entered into by and between the Collin County Sheriff's Department, (hereinafter called CCSD), and Collin County Mental Health - Mental Retardation Center, Inc., (Hereinafter called CCMHMRC).

I.

CCSD AGREES:

- A. To provide adequately trained professional Mental Health Deputies (3.0 FTE) sufficient to:
1. Provide initial screenings to determine need for immediate care for persons who are experiencing severe mental health and emotional crises.
 2. Be available for consultation with other professionals on an as needed basis regarding crisis intervention.
 3. Be available for court testimony on an as needed basis.
 4. Be available for consultation with CCMHMRC staff.
 5. Forward summary reports to CCMHMRC of all clients served on forms approved by CCMHMRC. Such forwarding will be done within five (5) days from the end of each calendar month.

II.

CCMHMRC AGREES:

- A. To provide to CCSD and maintain a list of CCMHMRC services and entrance criteria, other referral sources in the community, and other appropriate reference materials. CCMHMRC's Director for Mental Health Services shall be responsible for liaison with CCSD personnel.
- B. To provide appropriate training to CCSD personnel pursuant to this contract.
- C. To pay CCSD for services rendered following receipt of a bill from CCSD. The maximum reimburseable under this contract is \$90,300.00.

III.

CCSD will provide no matching funds. (\$.00)

IV.

CCSD and CCMHMRC MUTUALLY AGREE:

- A. The term of this agreement is from September 1, 1988, through August 31, 1989, contingent upon the availability of funds for the duration of this contract.
- B. That the program of services of CCSD provided pursuant to this contract shall be permitted to be examined and evaluated and the program's records inspected by either CCMHMR Board of Trustees, staff, or the Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation.
- C. All programs and services provided by this agreement shall be provided in accordance with the Rule of the Commissioner of the Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation; Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 as amended [42USC 2000 (d)]; Section 504 of the Vocational Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 USC 3 et seq); the Age Discrimination Act (42 USD 6101 et seq); and all federal rules and regulations, state laws and executive orders as applicable.
- D. To hold in strictest confidence all client-identifying information, to cooperate in exchange of any such information with the CCMHMRC as to subcontractor of the Center, and to release any such information only in compliance with Article 5561h, V.T.C.S.; Article 5547-300, Section 57, V.T.C.S.; and 42 CFR Part 2, as applicable.
- E. To indemnify and hold harmless CCMHMRC of and from all fines, suits, and demands of any kind by performance of the terms and conditions of this agreement.
- F. That the performance of the terms of this contract is contingent and expressly conditional upon the availability of Center funds.
- G. That either party may terminate this agreement for non-performance of the terms covered by this agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.
