

Spay/Neuter Agreement

This Spay/Neuter Agreement is made between the Collin County Animal Services, 4750 Community McKinney TX 75071, and SPCA of Texas (SPCA), 8411 Stacy Road, McKinney TX 75070.

Our Goal: To provide spay/neuter services to the Collin County Animal Services for dogs and cats that are adopted through Collin County Animal Services.

Transportation: Collin County Animal Services will provide the transportation to the Perry Clinic to deliver the adopted animals in need of spay/neuter surgery. The animals will be delivered the following business day after receipt of payment. The animal will be picked up at the Perry Clinic by the owner the afternoon the surgery was performed. If the owner does not claim their animal by the end of the day of surgery, Collin County Animal Services will pick up the animal and return it to the Collin County Animal Services shelter.

Paperwork: The adopter will come to the Perry Clinic to complete the Surgery Authorization Form. At that time, adopter will provide a copy of the animals kennel card/adoption paperwork and medical/vaccination history. Surgery will not be performed on any animal that does not have completed paperwork.

The Perry Clinic will send a copy of the Surgery Authorization Form to Collin County Animal Services via fax before the end of the day the form is signed by the adopter.

Vaccinations: A current Rabies and DHLPP vaccination is required at the time of surgery, if no proof of vaccination is provided the SPCA of Texas will vaccinated the animal.
