Re: Coit Road Asphalt Upgrade Request

The cities of McKinney and Frisco have requested Collin County Public Works construct a temporary asphalt surface (5,280 feet or 1 mile) on Coit Road between Virginia Parkway and U.S. 380.

This proposed roadway is needed to provide a temporary asphalt surface which will provide an alternative route for motorists trying to avoid construction on Custer Road.

It is my understanding Custer is scheduled to begin construction in April of 2009. Public Work's has an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) in place with both entities to facilitate this request.

The I.L.A. Road Policy for Cities is as follows:

**Road and Bridge Policy – Cities Section II:
Reimbursement for Work Performed by Collin County**

Costs for road and bridge repairs or improvements will be as follows:

1. Cost of materials used for the project or one-half of the total project cost (including labor and equipment), whichever is greater, when the road is designated as a Collin County Mobility Plan Road.
2. Total cost including materials, labor and equipment if the road is not on the Collin County Thoroughfare Plan.

The cost to facilitate this request is as follows:

Materials:

Flex-base rock needed (4 inches compacted):	\$ 38,000.00
<u>Two-course asphalt (materials only):</u>	<u>\$ 42,000.00</u>
(Sub Total)	\$ 80,000.00
<u>Equipment and Labor cost:</u>	<u>\$ 65,000.00</u>
(Total Cost)	\$145,000.00

As Coit Road is on the Collin County Mobility Plan, Item No. 1, under R&B Policy for cities would apply.

Of the \$145,000.00 project cost, \$80,000.00 is the responsibility of McKinney and Frisco. As McKinney and Frisco share a mutual boundary, each entity will then be responsible for \$40,000.00 totaling \$80,000.00.

The \$80,000.00 represents the total cost of materials utilizing our Road Policy for cities.

Public Works can accommodate this request should the Commissioner's Court approve this I.L.A. request.
