


Ratification of the County Judge's Declaration of Disaster for flooding in Collin County, County Judge.



DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Collin on the 29th day of October, 2009, has suffered widespread damage from flooding that resulted in property damage and severely disrupted commerce and transportation as well as local government services; and

WHEREAS, heavy rainfall and widespread flooding required 18 road closures, 8 roads are damaged, the TxDOT bridge at Highway 5 and the East Fork of the Trinity River is closed for an extended period, a private road is washed out, Lake Lavon is 4.63 feet over capacity, and

WHEREAS, there is imminent threat of additional damage resulting from further rainfall, and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Collin County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE County Judge of Collin County:

- That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Collin County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Collin County.
- Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
- Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the County emergency management plan.
- That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
