



## *Sgt. Kimberly Munley*

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant KIMBERLY MUNLEY, a mother of two and a U.S. Department of Defense police officer, Texas, put her own life secondary to the need of others during a shooting rampage at Fort Hood, Texas, on November 5, 2009, that claimed the lives of 13 people and wounded 29 others; and,

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant MUNLEY confronted a heavily armed assailant in an unflinching act of courage, eliminated any further threat to the U.S. Soldiers she was sworn to serve and protect; and,

**WHEREAS**, this former soldier was shot twice and sustained life-threatening wounds herself in the line of duty as she exchanged fire with the gunman at close range; and,

**WHEREAS**, upon regaining consciousness from surgery on her own gunshot wounds, Sergeant MUNLEY's first comments were words of concern for the welfare of those caught in the line of fire that Thursday afternoon at Fort Hood, yet another unselfish act of a dedicated public servant and law enforcement officer;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, We, the Commissioners Court of the County of Collin, State of Texas, do hereby offer our sincere gratitude to Sergeant KIMBERLY MUNLEY for putting the lives of others before her own; and,

**OFFICIALLY DECLARE** her an honorary resident of Collin County for her heroism to her community, the State and our Nation.
