

Proposed Changes to Myers Park Use Policies

Opening two paragraphs:

1. Clarification that Myers Park is a Collin County park.
2. Clarification of facilities Event Center being one and what that includes, The Farm Museum being another and what that includes.
3. Clarification of Open Park land not listed as part of a facility.

Mission Statement:

1. Change 'showcasing the agricultural heritage of Collin County' to first focus of the park, then attracting shows and events.
2. Added: "In addition it is charged with protecting Collin County's historical assets by preserving the heritage of the past and present."
3. Added: "Myers Park is not considered as a revenue generating source for Collin County; however efficiency and cost management are required for day to day operations. Core Funding for Myers Park is provided annually through the Collin County budget."

Added Section:

1. Park Management

Myers Park Manager is responsible for scheduling and coordinating all activities at Myers Park to include the Event Center, Farm Museum, Collin County Junior Livestock Association, Boy Scouts of America, and all other public and/or private sponsored events and activities."

Reservations:

1. Added: "Reservations for private events (i.e. birthday parties, weddings, family reunions, retreats, etc.) may not be made more than nine months in advance."

Farm Museum:

1. Added full description John Wells building and Blacksmith Shop including information for school usage and picnic lunches.

Show Barn and Stall Barn:

1. Clarification to not allow heating or cooking devices without approval of Park Manager.
