The attached Commissioners' Court Agenda Request is to ratify the County Judge's previous acceptance of an Office of the Governor (OOG) grant (number 2261901). This grant was applied for through the Commissioners' Court during our last fiscal year, Court Order 2009-377-05-27. The grant was to originally be awarded on October 1, 2009 but due to governmental constraints was just recently awarded to us. Even though awarded late, the grant is still scheduled to end on September 30, 2010. In interest of time, the County Judge has approved acceptance of this grant on March 1, 2010.

This grant is to fund a full time child abuse forensic investigator with benefits and all equipment. The total grant award is \$158,413. I met with Budgeting, Purchasing, and the Auditor's Office earlier this week in reference to this grant. All parties are aware of the impact due to the late award of this grant and have agreed on a plan of action.

Because this grant pays all costs associated with this investigator there is no fiscal impact to Collin County.
