This proposal is to provide Architectural and MEP services for the following items:

1. Review of existing drawings and site visit to identify existing conditions. While on site, A/E will meet with Collin County personnel to identify design requirements and project goals.
2. Design an emergency generator system (which shall include new generator, ATS, and main circuit breakers) to provide emergency power to 100% of the existing system. This work shall be identified as bid alternate.
