

INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF DALLAS

This agreement is entered into by and between the County of Dallas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as Dallas County, and the **Collin County Sheriff's Office**, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as **Collin SO**, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 791.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Dallas County and the Collin SO wish to participate in a joint operation funded by the and Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority of the State of Texas, with funding in the amount of \$1,331,074.00 for the investigation and reduction of auto theft and auto burglaries within the service area, and

WHEREAS, The Collin SO has agreed to contribute the total of **\$21,614.00** in matching funds and shall contribute personnel; and

WHEREAS, the source of funds would not normally be used for this purpose and personnel would not be normally assigned for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, Dallas County and Collin SO believe it to be in their best interests to join in the development of a Task Force for the investigation and reduction of auto theft and auto burglaries within the service area; and

WHEREAS, Dallas County and the Collin SO agree that the Collin SO employee assigned as an investigator to the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force shall remain an employee of the Collin SO and be operationally assigned to the Task Force Headquarters located in the Crowley Courts Building at 133 North Riverfront Blvd., 1st floor, Dallas, Texas, being a central location for the service area.

WHEREAS, Dallas County and the Collin SO agree to each accept the responsibility to adhere to all pertinent federal, state, local laws or regulations and Dallas County policies.

WHEREAS, Dallas County shall reimburse the Collin SO a sum covering 80% of the Salary and Fringe Benefits not to exceed **\$86,457.00** dollars from the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force Grant for the investigator. The vehicle to be used by the investigator shall be provided by the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force. Other equipment will be provided to the investigator by the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

PURPOSE

- 1.01 The purpose of this agreement is to allow Dallas County and the Collin SO to participate in the joint operation of the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force, with the Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority, which award is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof for all purposes.

ARTICLE II

TERM

- 2.01 The term of this agreement is to commence on September 1, 2010 or the execution of this agreement, if later than September 1, 2010, and to end August 31, 2011. This agreement may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties hereto, or terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days prior notice thereof to the other of its intention to terminate upon the date specified in such notice.

ARTICLE III

CONSIDERATION

- 3.01 As consideration for this agreement, Collin SO agree to contribute personnel for the operation of the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force and shall contribute matching funds in the amounts as follows:
Collin SO \$21,614.00

ARTICLE IV

ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

- 4.01 The specific allocation of the Dallas County and the Collin SO fund is set out in the attachments to this agreement, marked as Exhibits "A" through "F" inclusive, and made a part hereof for all purposes.
- 4.02 The funds to pay for the investigator from the Collin SO shall be reimbursed to Collin SO upon the presentation of an invoice itemizing the expenditures to be reimbursed supported by payment records from the Collin SO.
- 4.03 The Collin SO shall present an invoice no later than every quarter. The quarterly invoicing shall be present on or before the last day of the month following the end of each quarter. The invoice for the grant year ending August 31, 2011 must be received in the office of the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force of Dallas County, Texas on or before October 31, 2011.

- 4.04 It is agreed between Dallas County and the Collin SO that the total reimbursement shall be 80% of actual expenses incurred and shall not exceed **\$86,457.00** in total reimbursement.
- 4.05 Each party paying for the performance of governmental functions or services must make those payments from current revenues available to the paying party.

ARTICLE V

OWNERSHIP OF EQUIPMENT

- 5.01 Upon termination of this agreement, ownership of equipment, hardware, and other non-expendable items will revert to Dallas County for which it was acquired, subject to the approval of the Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority of the State of Texas.

ARTICLE VI

AMENDMENTS

- 6.01 This agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of the parties hereto in writing to be attached to and incorporated into this agreement.

ARTICLE VII

LEGAL CONSTRUCTIONS

- 7.01 In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof and this agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

ARTICLE VIII


ENTIRE AGREEMENT



District Attorney Contract

WHEREAS, the office of the Collin County Criminal District Attorney of Collin County, Texas, and the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force are desirous of entering into a contract between the parties regulating the disposition of property and monies (as defined by law) seized by the Task Force pursuant to civil and criminal statutes of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the parties to this contract are identified as the District Attorney of Collin County, Texas (hereafter referred to as the District Attorney) and the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force, being that group organized pursuant to a grant by and through the Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority (hereinafter referred to as the Task Force); and,


WHEREAS, the District Attorney of Collin County, Texas has the duty to represent the State of Texas regarding forfeitures of property pursuant to various civil and criminal statutes; and,

WHEREAS, the Task Force has the duty to provide law enforcement service with particular emphasis on auto theft related offenses; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by and between the District Attorney and the Task Force, as follows:

1. The District Attorney shall diligently pursue all forfeiture actions which arise from operations initiated and investigated by the District Attorney and the Task Force, as follows:
 - a. Upon seizure of funds or property by the Task Force under the provisions of law, the Task Force shall provide for the custody of the seized funds or property until final disposition of the forfeiture action.
 - b. Upon final disposition of the Forfeiture action, all funds and all property attributable to the efforts of the Task Force shall be awarded to the Task Force.
2. All property and funds awarded to the Task Force under forfeiture action represent Program Income (see ABTPA Grant Application). Up to the total grant amount of \$ 1,331,074.00 these funds shall be added to the funds committed to the project in accordance with the Uniform Grant Management Standards, Subpart C, Section 25, Paragraph (g) (2). Any Program Income (forfeiture, etc.) in excess of the grant award amount may be retained by the grantee with ABTPA approval and must be used for purposes that further the objectives of the project.
3. This agreement shall be in effect for the term of the Task Force grant award dates, September 01, 2010, to August 31, 2011, It is Agreed and Noted.

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas, held on the 27th day of July, 2010, on the motion made by Mike Cantrell, Comm. District No. 2 and seconded by Maurine Dickey, Comm. District No. 1, the following Order was adopted:

WHEREAS, the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force's FY 2011 Texas ABTPA grant award was briefed to the Commissioners Court July 27, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force is a specialized multi-jurisdictional response to auto theft, auto burglaries and insurance fraud that includes personnel from Dallas County, Collin County, the National Insurance Crime Bureau and the Texas Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, the grant award is for the eighteenth consecutive year of ABTPA funding in the amount of \$950,488 in grant funds and with an in-kind match provided by participating agencies in the amount of \$380,586 for a total project cost of \$1,331,074 ; and

WHEREAS, the grant request complies with the Dallas County Strategic Plan, Strategy 3.2, Coordinate Programs and Systems to Reduce Crime in Dallas County. It is the desire of the Commissioners Court to continue this program.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Dallas County Commissioners Court approves acceptance of the North Texas Auto Theft Task Force's grant award from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority for \$1,331,074 and authorize the County Judge to sign all related documents.
