The purpose of this letter is to transmit the enclosed one-year agreement (September 1, 2010-August 31, 2011) that sets forth certain 9-1-1 provisions as prescribed by the Commission on State Emergency Communication, (CSEC) (State 9-1-1 Commission). The Agreements will affect the 13 sheriffs' offices and 30 police departments operating 9-1-1 communications centers within NCTCOG's 9-1-1 service area.

The intent of the Agreement is to help assure an effective operation of this service area's 9-1-1 network and to comply with Commission rules, regulations and policies. The Commission has rules that support this Agreement's provisions; namely, Rules, Program Policy Statements, and Best Practices of the Commission, as well as Chapter 771, Health and Safety Code, State Administration on Emergency Communications.
