


APPROVAL BY APPLICABLE ELECTED REPRESENTATIVE

Based upon the evidence presented to me, for the sole purpose of satisfying the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") and for no other purpose, I hereby approve the Bonds, the Tax-Exempt Loans and the facilities to be financed with a portion of the proceeds of the Bonds and the Tax-Exempt Loans and located within the County, all as described in the published Notice of Public Hearing attached to the Minutes and Certification of Public Hearing attached hereto as Exhibit A. This approval is not to be construed as (i) a representation or warranty by the County or the undersigned that the Bonds or the Tax-Exempt Loans will be paid or that any obligations assumed by any of the parties will, in fact, be performed, or (ii) as a pledge of the faith and credit of or by the County. Further, the fact that the undersigned has approved the Bonds and the Tax-Exempt Loans as required by the Code may not, in any event, be used as a sales device with respect to the Bonds or the Tax-Exempt Loans.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a public hearing to be held by the Tarrant County Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation (the "Issuer") on October 8, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of Texas Health Resources, 612 E. Lamar Blvd., Suite 900, Arlington, Texas 76011, with respect to a plan of finance including (i) one or more issues in one or more series or subseries of revenue bonds (the "Bonds") to be issued by the Issuer in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$150,000,000 and (ii) one or more loans (the "Loans") to be issued by the Issuer in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$200,000,000, the proceeds of which will be loaned to the Borrower (as defined below). The aforesaid public hearing is a "combined hearing" within the meaning of Treasury Regulation section 5f.103-2(d) and the location of said public hearing is within 100 miles of the seat of government of each participating governmental unit beyond whose geographic jurisdiction the hearing is conducted.

Proceeds of the Bonds will be loaned to the Borrower and a portion thereof used to (A) finance or refinance the purchase, development, construction, reconstruction, renovation, rehabilitation and/or equipping of the following health facilities: (i) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Fort Worth, 1301 Pennsylvania Avenue, Fort Worth, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (ii) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Plano, 6200 West Parker Road, Plano, Texas (Collin County, Texas); (iii) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Allen, 1105 Central Expressway, Allen, Texas (Collin County, Texas); (iv) Texas Health Arlington Memorial Hospital, 800 West Randol Mill Road, Arlington, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (v) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Dallas, 8200 Walnut Hill Lane, Dallas, Texas (Dallas County, Texas); (vi) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Stephenville, 411 North Belknap, Stephenville, Texas (Erath County, Texas); (vii) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Hurst Eules Bedford, 1600 Hospital Parkway, Bedford, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (viii) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Azle, 108 Denver Trail, Azle, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (ix) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Southwest Fort Worth, 6100 Harris Parkway, Fort Worth, Texas (Tarrant County); (x) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Cleburne, 201 Walls Drive, Cleburne, Texas (Johnson, County); (xi) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Kaufman, 850 Highway 243 West, Kaufman, Texas (Kaufman County); (xii) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Denton, 3000 North I-35, Denton, Texas (Denton County, Texas); and (xiii) a health facility located or to be located at 10001 Old Denton Rd., Fort Worth, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas) (collectively, the "Project"), and (B) refinance the Tarrant County Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation Texas Health Resources System Revenue Bonds Series 2008D currently outstanding in the aggregate principal amount of \$26,430,000.

Proceeds of the Loans will be used to refinance the Tarrant County Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation Texas Health Resources System Revenue Bonds Series 2008E, Series 2008F and Series 2008G (such bonds, together with the Tarrant County Cultural

Education Facilities Finance Corporation Texas Health Resources System Revenue Bonds Series 2008D are herein referred to as the "Refunded Bonds") currently outstanding in the aggregate principal amounts of \$36,140,000, \$75,500,000, and \$50,335,000, respectively. Proceeds of the Refunded Bonds were used to finance or refinance the construction, reconstruction, renovation, rehabilitation and/or equipping of the following health facilities: (i) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Fort Worth, 1301 Pennsylvania Avenue, Fort Worth, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (ii) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Plano, 6200 West Parker Road, Plano, Texas (Collin County, Texas); (iii) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Allen, 1105 Central Expressway, Allen, Texas (Collin County, Texas); (iv) Texas Health Arlington Memorial Hospital, 800 West Randol Mill Road, Arlington, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (v) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Dallas, 8200 Walnut Hill Lane, Dallas, Texas (Dallas County, Texas); (vi) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Stephenville, 411 North Belknap, Stephenville, Texas (Erath County, Texas); (vii) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Hurst Euless Bedford, 1600 Hospital Parkway, Bedford, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (viii) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Azle, 108 Denver Trail, Azle, Texas (Tarrant County, Texas); (ix) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Southwest Fort Worth, 6100 Harris Parkway, Fort Worth, Texas (Tarrant County); (x) Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Cleburne, 201 Walls Drive, Cleburne, Texas (Johnson, County); (xi) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Kaufman, 850 Highway 243 West, Kaufman, Texas (Kaufman County); and (xii) Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Denton, 3000 North I-35, Denton, Texas (Denton County, Texas).

The initial owner of the Project will be Texas Health Resources, Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Fort Worth, Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Plano, Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Allen, Texas Health Arlington Memorial Hospital, Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Dallas, Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Stephenville, Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Hurst Euless Bedford, Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Azle, Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Southwest Fort Worth, Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Cleburne, Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Kaufman, Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Denton, an affiliated tax-exempt corporation that will be located at 10001 Old Denton Rd., Fort Worth, Texas, or any other affiliated tax-exempt corporation (collectively, the "Borrower").






