**AN ORDER OF THE COLLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT ESTABLISHING
REGULATIONS FOR THE METAL RECYCLING BUSINESSES OF COLLIN
COUNTY, TEXAS, PURSUANT TO TEXAS OCCUPATIONS CODE CHAPTER 1956**

WHEREAS, Chapter 1956 of the Texas Occupations Code grants the Commissioners Court authority to regulate and license Metals Recyclers in the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 1956.003 of the Texas Occupations Code authorizes the Commissioners Court to issue a license or permit to a business to allow the business to act as a metal recycling entity and allows the County to charge a fee not to exceed \$250 for the issuance or renewal of the license or; and

WHEREAS, Collin County, by and through the Sheriff’s Office, has determined that a need exists to regulate the secondary metal recyclers due to wide spread property crimes involving stolen metals which are sold to such businesses in Collin County; and

WHEREAS, Collin County has determined that a system of licensing and regulating metals recyclers will help reclaim stolen property and deter and prevent theft and property crimes within Collin County and surrounding areas;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COLLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
COURT AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The foregoing recitals, having been found to be true and correct, are incorporated herein as findings of fact.
2. The Collin County Commissioners Court hereby approves the attached Regulations for Secondary Metal Recyclers, creating a licensing system for Secondary Metal Recyclers, such regulations attached hereto and incorporated into this Order by reference.
