REF: FY09 Public Health Emergency Preparedness Grant Discretionary Funding

Homeland Security is requesting that Commissioners Court approve acceptance of carryover FY09 Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Grant Discretionary Funding from the Centers for Disease Control through the Texas Department of State Health Services. The Commissioners Court approved the application for this funding on March 22, 2010.

The Texas Association of Local Health Officials (TALHO) has approached Collin County to work together on a system for automated reporting of school absentee data. TALHO has an existing system in the Houston area and this project will connect Collin County and the schools in Collin County to this system.

There is a 5% in-kind match requirement for these funds. Collin County Healthcare Services will provide the equivalent of \$4,090 in staff time hours and fringes to meet this requirement. There will be no other costs to Collin County.
