What is Collin County Committee on Aging?

- Providing meals on wheels & CCART transportation since 1976.
- All meals are prepared in McKinney and distributed countywide.
- CCART transports to dialysis, doctor's appointments, shopping, work, school and delivers meals.
- Since inception, has delivered more than 5 million meals and logged over 5 million miles.
- Utilizes over 25,000 volunteer hours each year just for meal delivery.
- CCCoA employees 57 people.



What is the Texans Feeding Texans Grant?

- A \$10 million state funded grant to expand and supplement the home delivered meal program (Meals on Wheels) at the county level.
- The Texas Legislature first created and funded this program three years ago.
- Legislation and program budget was signed and endorsed by Governor Rick Perry
- The grant is administered by the Office of Texas Agriculture Commissioner Todd Staples.



2010 Texans Feeding Texans Grant

- \$112,483.86 total grant including \$9,728.50 in Collin County Healthcare Funds
- Provided 22,497 meals between February 2010 through September 2010.



2011 Texans Feeding Texans

- Requires a County match of \$9,728.50 which is computed at .25 per senior in the County from the 2000 Census.
- Pass the attached resolution and submit to the Texas Agricultural Commissioner by November 1, 2010.
- Make match payment to CCAR after Feb 2011.
- The County payment will be matched over 10.5 times by the State.
