Ref: 10-33 Program- Military Sharing

The 10-33 program is a program allowing law enforcement agencies to use surplus military items. This includes weapons, vehicles and other items. Due to the nature of items to be utilized they require more information and accountability than other programs.

This program is one we are in already but must re-apply every 12 months. They have it now where there is not as much paperwork necessary for the 12 month update however we must initially do the full application again.

The program is important because it provides agencies a resource to obtain certain equipment for use at no cost other than what it takes to maintain the item. Some items require inventory accountability for the entire time an item is in service (i.e.) weapons.
