A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to hours of sale for beer and mixed beverages in certain counties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 105.03(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:

(c) In a city or county having a population of one million [~~800,000~~] or more, according to the last preceding federal census, or 500,000 or more, according to the 22nd Decennial Census of the United States, as released by the Bureau of the Census on March 12, 2001, a holder of a mixed beverage late hours permit may also sell and offer for sale mixed beverages between midnight and 2 a.m. on any day.

SECTION 2. Section 105.05(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:

(c) In a city or county having a population of one million [~~800,000~~] or more, according to the last preceding federal census, or 500,000 or more, according to the 22nd Decennial Census of the United States, as released by the Bureau of the Census on March 12, 2001, a holder of a retail dealer's on-premise late hours license may also sell, offer for sale, and deliver beer between midnight and 2 a.m. on any day.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
