Re: Donation of a Boat Cover for Sheriff's Office Patrol Boat

The Collin County Citizen Sheriff's Academy Alumni Association ("CCCSAAA") is requesting that the Commissioner's Court approve a donation by the Association to the Sheriff's Office. The monies are to be used for the acquisition and installation of a boat canopy/top on the SO's lake patrol boat, in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$820.00). This donation is consistent with the mission and purpose of the "CCCSAAA".

The boat is used to patrol Lake Lavon and is very active during the summer months improving the safety and providing security on the water. The boat does not have any cover to protect those on board from the sun or rain. A proper top will help to protect the deputies and volunteers from the elements increasing its use and improving their efficiency and working conditions.

A the general meeting of the "CCCSAAA" on June 8, 2011 the members voted unanimously to donate the funds from the association's account to the Sheriff's Office pending appropriate approval from the Commissioner's Court.
