Please don't make any changes yet – within 2 weeks after approval by the commissioners court, a 9-1-1 address correction letter will be sent to you, your emergency service dispatcher, your post office, and the Collin Central Appraisal District.

The County will provide road signs at the intersections with the 3300-block of Skyview Dr and State Highway 78, as indicated on the enclosed map.

The two Collin County Department of Public Safety (DPS) offices, in McKinney and Plano, will update the address on drivers licenses at no charge when shown the 9-1-1 address correction letter.

Property deeds are not affected by a change in address - even though the deed may reference a physical address, the legal description is the permanent property identifier. This office will provide an address verification letter at no charge, if ever needed in the future.
