Subject: Resolution, Proposed Improvements to SH 121 from SH 5 to CR 635/Fannin County Line – Engineering

On **October 24, 2011**, the Commissioners Court of Collin County, Texas, met in **regular session** with the following members present and participating, to wit:

During such session the court considered adoption of the following resolution in support of the SH 121 from SH 5 to CR 635/Fannin County Line project.

WHEREAS, improved traffic mobility in this region will compliment economic development, improve air quality, advance traffic safety, and generally enhance the quality of life for all residents; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Council (RTC) allocated Regional Toll Revenue (RTR) funds for the widening from a two lane to a four lane divided roadway along SH 121 SH 5 to East of FM 455 (CSJ #0549-03-018); and

WHEREAS, Collin County allocated 2007 Discretionary Bond funds to advance the Preliminary Engineering and Environmental Document for SH 121 from SH 5 to CR 635 or Fannin County Line. (2007 Bond Project 07-105)

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), and Collin County are proceeding through the environmental approval process and desire (1) the issuance of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) approval at the earliest possible date and (2) the construction of SH 121 from SH 5 to East of FM 455, so to enhance mobility in the region and achieve the resulting economic and social benefits.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. We affirm our support of the SH 121 from SH 5 to CR 635 improvements (CSJ #s 0549-03-018, 0549-03-021) proposed and specifically for the expedited completion of SH 121 from SH 5 to East of FM 455, CSJ #0549-03-018); and
2. We urge the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to make every effort to expedite the issuance of the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and environmental approval of SH 121 from SH 5 to CR 635 project.
