On November 24, 1997, the Commissioners' Court of Collin County, Texas, met in special session with the following members present and participating, to wit:





Local Government Code, Chapter 262, Section 262.024 (a) (7) (D) provides that Commissioners' Court may by order grant an exemption from competitive bidding requirements by accepting a statement of the existence of only one source from the Purchasing Agent and, if approved, enter into its Minutes the results of the vote taken.


Dear Ms. White

This letter is to inform you that Motorola Inc. should be considered the sole source provider for the service contract covering the County of Collin Communications equipment. Since many of the Software Programs, Circuits and protocol components of your Communications System are patented and proprietary to Motorola, we are prevented from offering full access to other than Motorola Personnel. Only Motorola can provide a single point of contact for this Enhanced Service package with Motorola factory support as part of the Maintenance Contract.

The Motorola service package will include the following services: Local field service will be sub-contracted to DFW Communications, an authorized Motorola Service Center. Motorola personnel will provide Engineering Software Support and Technical Field Support through or System Support Center to Collin County. Other service providers can not guarantee the same response time and level of service Motorola has furnished during the last nine years. We have no control over non-Motorola staff or employees and can not support systems maintained by others.

Contracting directly with Motorola will assure the County that it's Communications System will continue to operate properly today and in the future.
