RESOLUTION NO. 2012-13(R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WYLIE, TEXAS, TO REQUEST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00 FROM THE 2007 COLLIN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION BOND PROGRAM BE USED FOR OTHER ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS INSIDE THE WYLIE CITY LIMITS INCLUDING ELM ROAD; LAKE ROAD, SKYVIEW ROAD/PAUL WILSON; WHEELIS ROAD (CR 455); BEAVER CREEK ROAD (CR 1105) AND CR 437.

WHEREAS, in 2008, the City of Wylie, Texas ("City") and Collin County, Texas ("County") entered into an Interlocal Agreement ("Interlocal Agreement") to jointly fund Stone Road Improvements from Akin Lane to County Line Road ("Stone Road Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City and County agreed to participate jointly by each entity contributing an amount of \$5,021,250.00 from their respective bond transportation programs; specifically, the 2005 City Bond Program and the 2007 County Bond Program; and

WHEREAS, County representatives have approached the City and indicated that they now desire to reallocate \$500,000.00 of the County's commitment toward the Stone Road Project to accomplish certain improvements to Elm Road, Lake Road, Skyview Road/Paul Wilson, Wheelis Road (CR 455), Beaver Creek Road, and CR 437; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement allows for the joint participation of road improvements.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WYLIE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of Wylie, Texas ("City Council") hereby requests that the County designate funds from the Stone Road Project in the amount of \$500,000.00 to be re-allocated for improvements to Elm Road; Lake Road; Skyview Road/Paul Wilson; Wheelis Road (CR 455), Beaver Creek Road (CR 1105) and CR 437, all within the City limits.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
