

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-05-14-R

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON, TEXAS,
TO WORK DIRECTLY WITH COLLIN COUNTY PUBLIC
WORKS DEPARTMENT TO PROCEED WITH PAVING THE
COUNTY/MUNICIPALITY SHARED BOUNDARY ROADS;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Princeton, Collin County, Texas (“City”) currently operates as a Type-A general law municipality under Chapter 6, Texas Local Government Code, and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2011 Commissioners Court voted to proceed with paving the County/Municipality shared boundary roads; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners voted to allow the 2007 Bond Program funds to be used to fund these shared road paving projects, for municipalities that are incapable of funding their portion of these projects; and

WHEREAS, the projects for the City of Princeton include CR 456, CR 408 CR 400 and CR 492; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Princeton, Collin County, Texas, hereby directs the City Manager to proceed with working with the Collin County Public Works Department to refurbish and repave the boundary roads indicated in this Resolution.

Section 2. The City Council acknowledges that the funding for this project will be provided by reducing the 2007 Collin County bond project allocation for Princeton and no city funds will be used in this project and the total bond reduction will be \$332,603.28.

Section 3. This Resolution is approved, during the open session of a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of the City of Princeton, duly noticed consistent with the Open Meetings Act, by a majority affirmative vote of the governing body of the City.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately after its passage.


