Rodney-

This is in response to your request for approximately \$650,000 to pull out of one of the 2007 County Bond projects to cover the City share of paving gravel roads along our common boundary.

We are recommending the funds be pulled out of the Custer (south of Stonebridge) project. This Custer project is the subject of current discussions with Frisco and County to swap responsibilities for two projects. Coit NB lanes would be McKinney responsibility and Custer Lanes 5&6 would be Frisco responsibility.
