NTTA Proposed Legislation: Materials Attached

Good morning, Judge Self and Commissioners.

Following adoption of the NTTA's 2013 legislative goals by the Board of Directors in June 2012, the NTTA committed to share with our member counties the proposed draft legislation outlining each of those goals.

Attached for your review are six documents:

- (1) the NTTA's Board-adopted 2013 legislative goals;
- (2) the draft toll enforcement remedies legislation;
- (3) an accompanying flow chart depicting the proposed enforcement remedies in the NTTA's existing toll collection process;
- (4) a "fast facts" one-pager on the NTTA's toll collection process and toll revenue;
- (5) the draft Texas Transportation Code Chapter 366 enhancements legislation; and
- (6) an overview of the Chapter 366 enhancements legislation.

We plan to forward these documents to legislative council this week so that they may begin their own review and preparation for bill filing. This step does not negate any opportunity for input from our member counties but is rather an effort to keep the process moving as the legislative session nears.

Outreach continues with the North Texas legislative delegation, key Austin leadership and other stakeholders, including but not limited to the Tax Assessor-Collectors, Justices of the Peace, Auto Dealers, DPS, tolling authorities, TxDOT and TxDMV.
