RESOLUTION 2013-018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE REALLOCATION OF \$1,063,813.15 FROM THE 2007 COLLIN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION BOND PROGRAM TO BE USED FOR OTHER ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS; AUTHORIZING COLLIN COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS TO PROCEED WITH PAVING THE COUNTY/MUNICIPALITY SHARED BOUNDARY ROADS.

WHEREAS, the City of Celina is a Home Rule Municipality located in Collin County and Denton County, Texas, created in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas and the Constitution of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2011 the Collin County Commissioners Court voted to proceed with paving the County/Municipality shared boundary roads; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court voted to allow the 2007 Bond Program funds to be used to fund these shared road paving projects for municipalities that are incapable of funding their portion of these projects; and


WHEREAS, the projects for the City of Celina include CR 6, CR 9, CR 50, CR 51, CR 52, CR 53, CR 57, CR 100, CR 102, CR 130, and CR 970; and

WHEREAS, the City has already allocated a portion of the funding needed to complete the project in the amount of \$390,000.00 in the General Obligation Bond Series 2012; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS:


- Section 1:** The Celina City Manager is hereby authorized to proceed with working with Collin County Public Works to pave the mutual boundary roads indicated in this Resolution.
- Section 2:** The City Council of the City of Celina hereby requests that the County reduce the funds allocated in the 2007 Collin County Transportation Bond Program for CR 5/Frontier Parkway in the amount of \$1,063,813.15 and reallocate them for improvements of the mutual boundary roads indicated in this Resolution.
- Section 3:** This Resolution shall be in full force and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
