

The following edits and clarifications to the FY14 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) have been made based on Commissioners Court comments.

1. The funding agency allows for the Juvenile Board to serve as the Local Advisory Board. The Juvenile Board consists of the County Court at Law, District Court, and County Administrative Judges.
2. The gift cards referenced in the grant are obtained through donations from team and community members as incentives for participants achieving particular goals/meeting milestones. These are not Wal-mart cards. These incentives are not purchased with County funds, participant fees, or grant monies.
3. Dollar amounts have been changed to reflect expenditures. Prior to FY12, the Juvenile Drug Court did not have an expense account, and this zero value was carried over from the previous application. The revenue for all drug courts (County, District, and Juvenile) in FY12 was \$100,981, of which the juvenile drug court expended \$17,223.
4. The "Sources of Financial Support" question pertains to all grant monies for the entire County and is derived from the single audit. It is not specific to the juvenile drug court, nor was any of these funds directed to the juvenile drug court program.
