

Teen Court currently refers teens to substance abuse and mental health evaluations and treatment; however, many Teen Court participants cannot afford either. Teen Court is requesting grant funds to fund evaluations, monthly drug testing (3 months), and weekly 1-hour counseling/treatment sessions (10 weeks) for 20 participants, as well as monies to purchase a short, behavioral and substance abuse screening tool. The screening tool will be completed by all Teen Court participants and be used as an initial assessment to determine the need for further evaluation.

From the "Lobbying" section (application page 8) until the Budget (page 11), questions are answered for the county government as a singular entity and are not project or department specific. For instance, the "Sources of Financial Support" section (p. 9) pertains to all grant monies expended by Collin County and is derived from the most recently completed single audit. It is not specific to the Teen Court program, nor was any of these funds directed to the Teen Court program.
