Re: Use of Open Space Funds to Construct Permanent Concrete Pads for the Granary and Confinement Buildings Located at Myers Park

Collin County is responsible for maintaining and preserving the Granary and Confinement Buildings located at Myers Park. The buildings, which are located north of the Pole Barn, sit unanchored, on wood blocks. Both buildings are frame and have suffered visible structural damage in recent years due to ground movement. (see attached photos)

Myers Park recommends that two permanent concrete pads, one for each building, be constructed west of the pole barn adjacent to the Blacksmith Shop and each building moved. A location map showing the current and proposed location of each structure is attached for your reference.

We realize this request falls outside the normal Open Space Project Funding cycle. However, the pictures shown in the PowerPoint presentation clearly depict the condition of these historic buildings. There is a sense of urgency to move both structures to a stable location prior to beginning restoration.

We are requesting Commissioners Court's authorization to utilize \$20,000 from the 2007 Open Space Bond account and will be available to answer any questions you might have regarding this project.
