Re: Collin County Historical Markers

Public Works received a request from the Collin County Historical Commission to place two historical markers in Collin County.

The first recognizes the historical significance of Wylie Cemetery which was established in 1889. Several cemetery founders are interred here as well as veterans from the Civil War to the Vietnam War. The Wylie Cemetery Association continues to maintain the cemetery to this day.

The second recognizes the First Presbyterian Church of Prosper which traces its roots to 1878 as the McAdew Congregation of Cumberland Presbyterian Church. It has served a significant role in the community throughout the years. In addition to providing spiritual guidance for well over a century, the church provides charitable services, weekly revivals, funerals, senior citizen day, and transportation services.

The Historical Commission furnished the markers and mounting accessories which will require only nominal expense to install. As such, Public Works requests Commissioners' Court approval to facilitate this request.
