
In 2007, Princeton ISD built a new elementary school at the corner of CR398 and CR447. Since then, CR398 has experienced a significant increase in traffic due to school buses and parents of the school children. Today, the full length of CR398 is rock with the exception of a short stretch on the school's border which PISD paved in conjunction with the school's construction.

With the additional traffic, Public Works has received numerous requests to oil the road for dust control. Normally, PW only oils a 500 foot stretch of road centered along a resident's property line. This process is initiated by either a health letter or a resident paying for the service. Due to the prevailing nature of the traffic on CR398 (school children), PW staff believes a community responsibility is inherent in this instance to ameliorate safety for all drivers. Therefore, Public Works requests Commissioners' Court consideration and approval to apply dust control on the rock portion of CR398.
