Re: Snow Hill Cemetery

The Snow Hill Cemetery Board has requested Public Works' assistance with renovating the historic cemetery.

Snow Hill Cemetery was founded in 1885 and is located on County Road 621 between Blue Ridge and Farmersville. Although small, the cemetery has historical significance serving as the burial place for some of Collin County's founders.

In 2011, Commissioners' Court approved Public Works and the Cemetery Board's request to supply fill dirt for eroded areas in a continuing effort to restore the property. Currently, the Board has solicited the aid of Public Works to provide fill dirt and grading where trees have been removed on the back slope of the ditch.

Public Works receives most of our fill dirt from various construction projects free of cost and could execute this request with minimal expenditure and resources. Public Works requests Commissioners' court consideration and approval to assist the Snow Hill Cemetery board with their restoration effort.
