

According to Section 31.0211 of the Texas Education Code, school districts are entitled to an annual allotment from the state to provide instructional materials for Juvenile Justice Alternative Educational Programs. The Texas Educational Agency has approved the purchase of two smart boards and the accompanying cameras and audio systems as well as the required cables, connectors and hardware. These boards will be installed by Collin County Facilities and will be for the Science and Math classrooms located in the JJAEP at 4690 Community in McKinney. The total cost of the project is \$12,042.34. There are no other known expenses or continuing expenses for the project.
