Re: Request for Grant Application Waiver for Prostitution Prevention Program Under S.B. 484

Dear Judge Self:

Pursuant to Section 169A.0055(a), Texas Health and Safety Code, effective September 1, 2013, a county that has a population of more than 200,000 is required to establish a Prostitution Prevention Program. Section 169.0055(c) further provides a county is required to establish a prostitution prevention program only if the county receives sufficient federal or state funding specifically for that purpose.

The Governor's Criminal Justice Division (CJD) is in receipt of your documentation regarding the establishment of a prostitution prevention program in compliance with SB 484. Upon due consideration, CJD is unable to provide funding to Collin County for said purpose.
