> As a reminder, Collin County is the anchor for RHP 18 for the Medicaid 1115 Waiver Program. Per
our contract with Public Information Associates, they are responsible for collecting and reporting
information from each of the participating providers to HHSCS. Our contract required them to find a
software package that can be utilized by reporting participants (clinics and hospitals) and consolidated
into state reporting formats. Performance Logic (PL) is a software reporting tool that the RHP 18
participants have each acquired on their own to collect this information. PL also appears to be the
standard reporting software for entities in the entire DFW area. It appears to be a niche product and I
am unaware of any competing products. I'm not sure if the PIA contract is worded for the County to
acquire the software directly or PIA is to acquire and submit as an expense. This is a web based system
that is remotely hosted and there are no hardware or software requirements for the County. Attached is
a justification memo for the selection by PIA. Please tell me how to proceed with the acquisition.
