

Collin County Housing Project Finance Assistance Program

The Collin County Housing Project Finance Assistance Program has been developed in 2012 to assist, through competitive grants, existing non-profit organizations to build and/or upgrade housing in Collin County. This program allows qualified organizations to apply for competitive grants to build or upgrade, such as additional rooms, handicapped facilities, etc. The grant program is administered by the Collin County Planning Board on behalf of the Collin County Housing Finance Corporation. The Collin County Housing Finance Corporation will have the final decision on awarding of grants.

Program Highlights

- Grants will be provided for housing and sheltering;
- All grants will require matching funds which must be available when the application is made. Matching funds may direct cash, value of land to be improved, material, or specialized in-kind services;
- All proposals must explain how grant would benefit Collin County legal entities;
- All projects must be started within 6 months of the award notification and completed within 18 months of the award date;
- Only existing non-profit organizations may apply;
