As we discussed, the City of Celina has entered into a formal development agreement with the Collin County Municipal Utility District No 1, commonly known as Light Farms. The District "Light Farms" is obligated to reimburse the City for Police/Fire/EMS services. As part of that Agreement, the City is obligated to provide Police/Fire/EMS services to the entirety of the District which is located within Celina's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

This agreement also includes alarm permits in this district. Furthermore, all fines/citations will be processed through the Celina Municipal Court.
