American Traffic Solutions mounts cameras onto the school buses. When a vehicle “runs the reds” while a bus is stopped to load or unload students, it is recorded on the cameras, along with location, date, time stamp from GPS that is also installed with the camera. American Traffic Solutions sends the information to the city and/or county. The city and/or county would then accept or reject the information sent to them. If they accept the information, American Traffic Solutions issues a citation to the owner of the vehicle that was captured on the camera.

In a traffic study conducted by Durham School Services over the past ten days, vehicles who ran reds past the buses averaged 32.2 per day within the McKinney Independent School District boundaries.

Funds received from violators will be distributed at a to be determined ratio.
