RE: Contract Renewal for Year 2 of Current Agreement

Dear Ms. Hoglund:

I hope this letter finds you well. This letter shall serve as CHC official request for an increase in the annual compensation for Year 2 of our current agreement effective October 1, 2013. Per Section 9.3 of our agreement, subsequent years of the agreement shall include a reasonable increase at the end of each twelve month period to insure the delivery of the same quality and quantity of health services. The annual increase in compensation is to be calculated using the Department of Labor's Consumer Price Index for Medical Care Services, Dallas/Fort Worth, Texas. The current CPI is 2.59%; therefore, CHC is requesting an increase in the current annual amount by 2.59% to account for the rising costs in providing quality healthcare services to Collin County.

For professional health care services provided at the Collin County Detention Center, the Collin County Minimum Security Facility, and the John R. Roach Juvenile Detention Center, CHC will charge \$353,858.04 per month from October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015, or \$4,258,296.48 annually. All terms of the current Agreement, including any changes detailed above, shall remain in full force and effect through September 30, 2015.
