

## Myers Park & Event Center Improvements ~ Park Pavilion

### 1. Park Pavilion

McKinney is experiencing growth to its Northwest corner with the addition of Baylor Hospital and the many housing editions under construction which are encroaching closer to Myers Park & Event Center. Myers Park is a large portion of park and open space that is being preserved and strategically developed to support the recreational needs of Collin County.

This request is for the purchase, shipping, and installation of a 30' X 40' metal pavilion on a concrete pad and six (6) powder coated picnic tables.

The construction of the concrete Pad 34' x 44' will include excavation, footings and masonry work necessary as specified by the pavilion company.

The pavilion system is 30' x 40', 12" Standing Seam Design Span Roof, 10:12 Roof Pitch, 8' Eave Height, Tube Steel Fascia, 6 Columns, Surface Mount, TGIC Poly Powder coat w/Zinc Rich Primer, Standard Ornamentation, Provision for Electrical, Extra Beam for Ceiling Fan, (4) Gussets on End Columns, Solar Light Kit and 2 additional Lights, (1) Medium Size Screw on Louvered Cupolas. Texas Engineer Stamp

The Rectangular Expanded Steel Tables have thick plastisol coating permanently heat fused to heavy-duty steel creating an impervious rustproof barrier, which is then encapsulated with tinted high performance powder coating creating a seal against the elements while providing a finish unmatched in durability. These tables come with a 20 year warranty.

### 2. Objectives

Myers Park Pole Barn pavilion serves many purposes, such as a gathering spot for family and friends during birthday parties, reunions, weddings, etc. This has contributed to Myers Park & Event Center's overall usage which has increased 53% over the past 5 years. The current outdoor pavilion is regularly booked causing us to turn away other events resulting in the need for an additional picnic shaded structure in an alternate location.

The Amphitheater addition further develops the mid-section of the park contributing to the parks' evolving variety of programs and events. Therefore, a pavilion located close to the newly constructed restrooms and established research/demonstration gardens of crape myrtles, roses, and vegetables is the ideal setting to provide shade/shelter during events or for the general public experiencing the park's activities. Often school groups, Boy Scout groups, Texas A & M AgriLife and Collin County Master Gardeners are looking for a place to hold outdoor classes, picnics and other gatherings.

This project will involve some excavation leveling of the actual site, pouring of the concrete slab by a separate contractor per specs and drawings provided by the pavilion company. Once slab is installed the pavilion company will assemble the pavilion.
