

2. **Delegation of Approval Authority.** The Collin County Director of Homeland Security is hereby delegated the full power and authority to execute interlocal agreements, memorandums of understanding and similar instruments with other jurisdictions for sharing of data in connection with the North Central Texas Fusion Center, save and except such authority is limited to only those agreements and instruments that do not require an additional expenditure of County funds and which do not impose any additional liability on Collin County. Such agreements and instruments, once executed by the Collin County Director of Homeland Security shall be fully binding on Collin County as if said approval thereto was granted by the Commissioners Court.

3. **Retained Authority of Commissioners Court.** The Commissioners Court retains the authority to approve any agreements or instruments which do not meet the guidelines set forth in this Order, it being intended that the delegation of authority to the Collin County Director of Homeland Security as memorialized in this Order is of a limited nature and subject to the further control of the Commissioners Court, as it may find necessary. This Order may be rescinded at any time by a majority vote of the Commissioners Court.

4. **Compliance with Texas Open Meetings Act.** The meeting at which this Order was considered and passed was duly noticed and held in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, ch. 551 Tex. Gov't. Code.
