
Brief Description
Funding to continue Collin County Mental Health Managed Counsel program to improve the representation quality to indigent defendants with mental health illness. This will be the 4th year of the project. FY13 originally funded at \$250,774 TIDC + \$62,694 County match (80% / 20%); FY14 funded at \$183,296 TIDC + \$99,704 County match (60% / 40%); and FY15 funded at \$122,633 TIDC + \$160,367 County match (40% / 60%). FY Anticipated funding for FY16 will be 20% TIDC + 80% county match with expected dollar values of \$66,034 TIDC + \$216,966 County match.
