

GENERAL DISQUALIFICATIONS (GC 62.102)

DO NOT APPEAR IF:

- I am under 18 years of age
- I am not a citizen of the United States (if marked, your Collin County voter registration will be deleted)
- I am not a resident of Collin County (if marked, your Collin County voter registration will be deleted)
- I have been convicted of a theft or felony
- I am under indictment or accusation for a theft or felony
- I am currently serving deferred adjudication for a theft or felony

POSSIBLE DISQUALIFICATION

- I have a physical or mental disability that would interfere or prevent me from serving as a juror. (This request must include a statement from a doctor. If no letter is provided, you will be expected to appear)
- I cannot read or write (You must report on your scheduled date to appear before a judge)

EXEMPTIONS (GC 62.106)

DO NOT APPEAR IF:

- I am over 70 years of age
- I wish to claim a permanent exemption because I am over 70 years of age

If you indicate one of the following, you will receive a status update from Jury Services:

- I have legal custody of a child under 12 years of age and the child would be left without adequate supervision
- I am a student (Parents may sign for juror)
- I have appeared for a jury summons for Collin County within the last 24 months
- I am a primary caretaker of an invalid unable to care for him/herself (Does not apply to healthcare workers)
- I am on active U.S. military duty deployed outside Collin County (Parent/spouse may sign for juror)
- I am an officer or employee of the Senate, House of Representatives, or any department, commission, board, office, or other agency in the legislative branch of state government. (Does not include law enforcement)

- NO FOOD/DRINK ALLOWED IN JURY ROOM
- CLOTHING: **NO SHORTS/UNIFORMS/INAPPROPRIATE CLOTHING** allowed. Jurors who dress inappropriately will be rescheduled for jury duty.
- TERM OF SERVICE: Court hours are generally 8:00am – 5:00pm but may vary. If you wish to bring something to occupy your time, feel free to do so as you may spend time waiting. Free WiFi access is available. If you are selected as a juror to participate in a trial, the trial will usually begin immediately after jury selection unless otherwise ordered by the judge. Your jury service will end when the trial is completed. If you are not selected as a juror your service will conclude at the end of jury selection. **You may print an employer excuse letter at collinjuror.org.**
- FAILURE TO APPEAR: Willful disobedience of your summons is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 or more than \$1,000 (GC 62.0141).
