Major Palmisano,

Please accept this correspondence as our Official Notice to Terminate Dispatch Services with the Collin County Sheriff's Office as required by an Inter-Local Agreement which was updated July 16, 2014. The *Council of Governments (COG)* was able to move our *Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP)* project forward which created an earlier timeline to establish our Dispatch Services with the City of Murphy Police Department. Therefore, it is our request to effectively terminate this agreement, if possible, on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> of July, 2015. Should this date not work, please advise what date would be more acceptable.

As a reminder in our earlier Memorandum to the COG, the Parker Police Department had entered into two (2) *Interlocal Agreements (ILA's)* to better assist our Police Department with meeting the needs of our citizens and our own dispatch services.

The first agreement is with the cities of Plano and Allen for the infrastructure for radio services and the other is with the City of Murphy for dispatch services. Our current answering point is the Collin County Sheriff's Office, who have been notified of our intent and of the agreement(s). As far as our timeline, it is my understanding it will take the Council of Governments (COG) approximately forty five (45) days or less to make the transfer, which is estimated to be on or before the 23<sup>rd</sup> of June, 2015

Once the transfer is complete, the City of Parker is required to give the Collin County Sheriff's Office a ninety (90) day notice of terminating our dispatch services agreement, giving us an estimated ending date on or before the 21<sup>st</sup> of September, 2015. (Please see attached ILA's)

Again we are requesting to terminate Dispatch Services on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> of July, 2015 due to the COG being able to move our PSAP request to the Dispatch Center at the City of Murphy in less time than originally estimated.




