- James Andrew Rodeo Company will provide livestock, 2 pick-up men, labor, trucking, 2 judges, 2 bull fighters, arena director, rough stock, and timed event cattle, an announcer and sound, secretary and timers, timers, contract act (clown entertainment).
- BRRC committee will provide added prize money, insurance, ambulance, tractor, drag, and driver, 18 square bales, 10 sacks of grain, arena maintenance and labor.

Sanitation and Health Plan:

The BRRC Board is committed to attendee's sanitation and health by providing 1 fifty gallon trash barrel for every 100 people in attendance located in the parking areas, entrances, concession stand, bleacher areas and walkways. BRRC members will be emptying trash throughout the event to avoid overflow. In addition to stand-alone bathrooms that have 6 toilets, the board will be leasing portable bathrooms to increase the number to 14, 2 of which being ADA accessible. All bathrooms will be monitored by the board members for adequate toilet paper, paper towels, and soap.

Traffic Control Plan:

The BRRC Board will use CR 504 as the main thoroughfare for the event. The Blue Ridge FFA will be directing traffic to the different parking lots, separating the event attendees from the event contestants to keep traffic moving smoothly. The board will get also assistance from Collin County Sheriff's deputies for other areas that might get congested.
