Re: Collin Co. CR 1031/Hunt Co CR 2652 Upgrade

Public Works requests Commissioners Court consideration and approval to authorize an Inter-Local Agreement with Hunt County to facilitate permanent improvements to CR 1031/CR 2652.

CR 1031 is scheduled to be paved this year as part of the continuing effort to pave all county roads known as the 50 Miles Program. The road is composed of separate dirt and rock segments and spans two counties, Collin and Hunt. In addition, Royse City has either all or shared maintenance responsibility for the central portion of the road.

Since CR1031 ends abruptly midway across a field, representatives from Collin and Hunt County initiated discussions to upgrade the entire length of the road which includes 1,545' of Hunt County roadway. Both County officials along with Royse City believe the project would benefit the region and would enhance traffic flow through the area.

To that end, Collin County commissioned an ILA with Hunt County to formalize the cooperative nature of this project. Collin County crews will upgrade Hunt CR 2652 from the county line east until it dead ends at CR 2642. For this service, Hunt County will remit the sum of \$81,900 to Collin County upon completion. Furthermore, Royse City has agreed to cost participation in the amount of \$45,968 to finance their full and shared maintenance segments highlighted on the attached map. Funds have been budgeted and are available to facilitate the project using Public Works Project Account 75-29.
