Dear Commissioner Webb

A few years ago the north-south part of CR 209 was known as "Redden Drive". The County changed the name to CR 209 to be consistent with other roads in the County and to provide a location for 911 calls and an organized system for emergency calls.

Now a notification from GIS/Rural Addressing Office announces that they will change the identification of CR 209 to "Bourland Bend" effective immediately after Commissioners Court approval on 20 July 2015.

This is a regression and out of order with the numbering system now in place.

This change is being forced on the residents living on CR 209 with no input from them.

I understand the reasons for desiring a change to the E-W portion of CR209. (northbound traffic makes a sharp left hand turn at the NS-EW intersection) This EW portion of CR209 should logically be changed to CR 210 to maintain consistency.

If the road needs a name instead of a number, it should be changed to its historical name, "Redden Drive".

I urge you to reject their proposal and leave the N-S portion of road name as CR 209.
