Dear Ms. Osinalke:

American Medical Response (AMR) would like to exercise the CPI indicated amount as of November 1, 2015. As stated in the contract dated November 21, 2013:

4.2 A price re-determination may be considered by Collin County only at the anniversary date (November 1st of each year) of the contract. All requests for price re-determination shall be in written form, shall be submitted a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to November 1st of each year and shall include supporting documentation. Requests for price re-determination shall be based on the percentage increase for the previous twelve (12) month period in the medical component of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) (calculated to the next 1/19th of one percent (1%) of the South region for All Urban Consumers) as published by the United States Department of Labor. For purposes of this contract, the Medical CPI shall not exceed an annual increase of 3.0%

I have included an attachment for your review from the US BLS website the chart (see attached) which shows the South Region Medical cCPI of 1.9%. This equates to the dollar amount of \$15,485.00, which brings the total subsidy amount to \$830,485.00 effective November 1, 2015.
