Dear Mr. Salinas:

We request Federal assistance under the provisions of Section 216 of the Flood Control Act of 1950, Public Law 81-516 or Section 403 of the Agricultural Credit Act of 1978, Public Law 95-334, to restore damages sustained in Collin County by a series of excessive rainstorms that occurred from May 26, 2015 through June 2, 2015. This work is needed to safeguard lives and property from an imminent hazard of potential dam failure from severe slope failure on Floodwater Retention Structure, Site 19, Little Elm watershed.


We understand, as sponsors of an Emergency Watershed Protection project that our responsibilities will include any permits needed to repair this dam. We are prepared to provide local 25% match with the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board contributing 95% of the 25% local cost share of the cost of construction work in dollars or in-kind services.
