
On October 28, 1996, the Commissioners' Court of Collin County, Texas, met in special session with the following members present and participating, to wit:

RE Repair and/or Refurbishment of Heavy Equipment
Declaration of Sole Source Suppliers

I request that the original equipment manufacturers' (OEM) authorized service facility in the metroplex area for each of the following heavy equipment manufacturers be considered as sole-source suppliers pursuant to Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated, Local Government Code Section, 262.024, for the repair and/or refurbishing of their respective products:

This request is made in the interest of preserving our investment in each of these machines. Our specifications for repair/refurbishing of heavy equipment include the following special requirements:

- 1.) vendor must be a manufacturer's authorized service facility;
- 2.) repairs/refurbishments shall be done using only genuine OEM (captive) or OEM approved replacement parts;
- 3.) repairs/refurbishments shall be done only by OEM certified technicians/mechanics; and,
- 4.) warranty supplied by authorized service facility:
 - a.) for refurbishments/custom rebuilds: a (minimum) one-year warranty;
 - b.) for other repairs: (as appropriate to repair performed)

Due to the captive parts required for repairs/refurbishment to ensure that the repaired/refurbished equipment meets performance as designed by the manufacturer, and the requirement for OEM certified technicians, we believe that the OEM authorized service facility for each of the above-listed manufacturers (in the local or metroplex area) is the sole-source supplier for their respective products.
