Re: Tyler Professional Agreement – Redaction Software

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Information Technology is requesting approval to award a Odyssey Redaction Software Professional Services and licensing agreement to Tyler Technologies/CSI (Computing Systems Technologies) for Intellidact software that allows redaction capabilities and integration with our existing Odyssey Software.

Attached is a sole source letter from Tyler Technologies specifying that Tyler has executed a master framework agreement with Computing Systems Innovations (“CSI”) to integrate their Intellidact redaction solution into Odyssey. CSI is the sole solution provider with which Tyler has developed such an integration arrangement.

Funding for this project will be from project 03JUS in the amount of \$305,286.00. Software, license fees, professional services, and travel expenses will be invoiced by Tyler Technologies in the amount of \$266,384.00. First year software maintenance will be invoiced directly from CSI in the amount of \$38,902.00.

Currently the County uses Adobe to manually redact any requested Odyssey documents by the public or by required parties. This is very tedious, time consuming, and adds time to the case process. We are requesting to automate this process and gain other new capabilities in Odyssey system with this solution. Those capabilities include providing redacted Odyssey images online to the public, Judges electronic signature on required Odyssey documents, a Judges Search feature using Odyssey Judges Edition, Odyssey online Portal application, and allow our District Attorney’s Office to redacted judicial documents to share with required parties.
